Interim Budget: Sitharaman announces 3 major economic railway corridor programmes

NEW DELHI, 1 FEBRUARY

Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman, while presenting the Interim Budget 2024-25, on Thursday announced that three major economic railway corridor programmes will be implemented.

"These are energy, mineral and cement corridors, port connectivity corridors, and high traffic density corridors," she said. Ms Sitharaman said the railway projects have been identified under the PM Gati Shakti for enabling multimodal connectivity. They will improve logistics efficiency and reduce cost.

and comfort of passengers. Meanwhile, Railway Minister Ashwin Vaishnaw has said that an unprecedented budget allocation has been made towards the railway sector in the Interim Budget for the financial year 2024-25, which was presented by the Union Finance Minister.

Mr Vaishnaw informed that Indian Railways has been allotted a total of Rs 2,52 lakh crore outlay for the financial year 2024-25.

"Prime Minister Narendra Modi changed the entire strategy (for Railways) over the last 10 years, and now the focus is being made on investment to modernize the Railways. For this year, the budget that has been allocated for the Railways is Rs 2,52 lakh crore," the Railway Minister said.

In the Interim Budget, Ms Sitharaman said that the expansion of existing airports and development of new airports will continue expeditiously.

"The aviation sector has been galvanized in the past ten years. Number of airports have doubled to 149," she said. The Union Finance Minister said roll out of air connectivity to tier two and tier three cities under UDAN scheme has been widespread.
