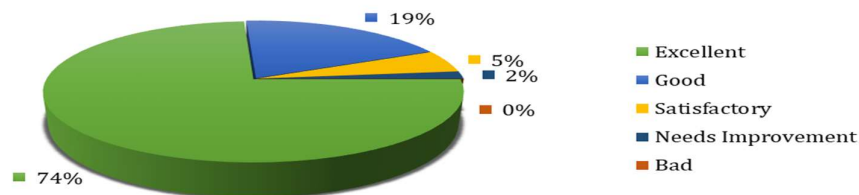
1. How would you rate the quality of education imparted in the college?



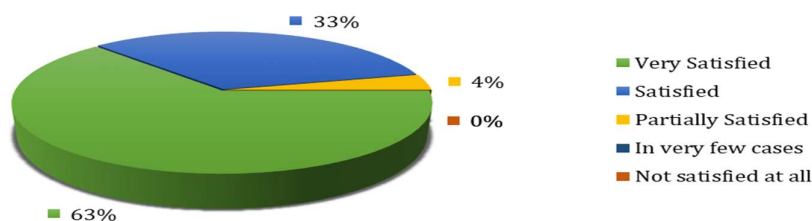
2. How would you rate the relevance of your degree to your present job?



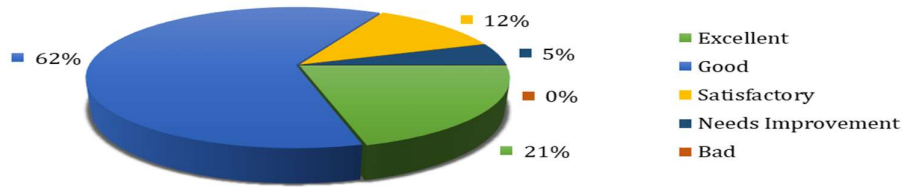
