POLICY DOCUMENT FOR AWARD OF SCHOLARSHIPS & FREESHIPS

The College has Student Support Cell to assist the students for getting different Government and non-government Scholarships and Government Free-ships and Institutional financial assistance throughout the year specially at the time of new entrants both in undergraduate and postgraduate levels. The following resolutions are being undertaken in the meeting held on 16.7.2018. in the Student Support Cell Room (ground floor) at 1.00 p.m. regarding consideration of the proposals of scholarships, freeships, any financial assistance and welfare measures for students of the college. Different scholarships including freeships are classified into four categories.

To facilitate application for and verification of existing Scholarships etc.:

Details of eligibility, date of application to be conveyed through the Student Support page of the College website. New entrants both in UG & PG Students are informed specially after completion of admission procedure and Registration to apply as per eligibility of Govt. Rules. After verification of submitted applications college authority sent to the concerned scholarships authority through online. In case of other non-government scholarships students are informed through notification and college website time to time.

- Students will be intimated about this scheme via the college website.
- Scholarship amount: Rs. 5000/- or as per requirement, whichever is less.

One-Time Institutional Scholarship for the categories of SC, ST and OBC.

<u>Eligibility</u>:

- Not received government / private scholarships.
- Severe economic impoverishment despite receiving grants.
- Boarders of College Hostel or private hostels/ living in Paying Guest accommodations/ outstation students living on their own.
- Scholarship amount: Rs. 5000/- or as per requirement, whichever is less.

Institutional Scholarship and other facilities for the category of the Students with Disabilities/ PH / DIVYANGJAN.

- The college authority will provide lift facility.
- Students will be intimated about the scholarship via the college website.
- Applications seeking aid must contain details of the amount sought, head of expenses and reasons for availing them along with a Family Income Certificate (to be issued by an elected representative in the local administrative body). The student must clearly mention their department, semester, email ID and WhatsApp number.
- Applications may be submitted to the Head of the Department/ in a drop-box/ mailed to the Student Support Cell.
- A drop-box will be set up in the Students' Section for submission of applications seeking aid. Proper instructions will be pasted on the drop-box. It will be emptied once a week.
- The Head of the Department of the applicants will verify and forward the applications to the committee.

Institutional scholarship for needy students if he/she is unable to pay the required amount necessary for Study Tour/ Excursion/ Field Trip.

- Financial Assistance may be given on the basis of the student's requirements. Final decision will be taken by the Principal and by the concerned committee members.
- To be provide once per semester.
- Study Tour/ Excursion/ Field Trip must be part of the curriculum.
- Scholarship amount: Rs. 5000/- or as per requirement, whichever is less.

Free-ship to any economically weak student of the UG/ PG levels in the form of Full/ Half-Tuition Fee Waiver.

- Notification for the application for free ship has been generally issued between 15th Nov and 15th Feb (of the next year) each year/ after registration.
 <u>Eligibility</u>:
- Severe economic impoverishment despite receiving grants.
- Boarders of College Hostel or private hostels/living in Paying Guest accommodations/outstation students living on their own.
- Students of any dept. / course/ semester can apply.
- Students whose annual family income is less than Rs. 24,000 are eligible for full-free ship and students whose annual family income is more than that are eligible for half-free ship, in accordance with the **G.O. No. 272-Edn (T)/ 10M-06/2010, dated 1.7.2011.**
- A proper income certificate is to submitted issued by any officer of the State Govt. in the rank of BDO/above in the district/ their equivalent counterparts (Group A Officer) elsewhere.

Institutional free ship /scholarship/ stipend for college hostel-boarders.

- Scholarship amount: Rs. 5000/- or as per requirement, whichever is less.
- Students in extreme economic distress are eligible for free ship with regard to hostel boarding expense.

Special Financial Assistance for Medical exigency/emergency.

• Financial Assistance amount as per actual requirement on recommendation.
