THE OBJECTIVES OF THE MOU:

- The MOU involves activities primarily organized by both under graduate Department of Mathematics, Calcutta Girls'College and Under graduate Department of Mathematics, Maulana Azad College.
- These Departments after discussion and on mutual consent may also collaborate with other Research Institutes/Universities Laboratories/IITs/Autonomous Universities for Interdisciplinary lectures/hands on training/workshops.
- Both departments shall work towards the further enrichment in the quality of teachingat both undergraduate and postgraduate level by the following exchange programmes;
 - a. Faculty Exchange Programme
 - b. Student Exchange Programme
 - c. Remote Usage of Library

Faculty exchange program - The Mathematics departments of the above institutions shall be exchanging their faculties (online/offline as the case may be) in order to impartlectures that will enhance knowledge of the students. This may involve students from undergraduate curriculum.

- Student exchange program Each of the institutions will be sending over the willingstudents to
 the other institution's campus to learn relevant and allied topics from the other discipline through
 seminar/workshop/hands on training etc.
- Utilization of Library resources Students can access e resources available at the Library at both Colleges.
- Joint research activities The above institutions shall co-operate, explore in collaborative interdisciplinary research wherever feasible.
- 8. Both departments shall also be engaged in organizing activities as mentioned below involving teaching and non-teaching staff members of both Colleges:
 - a. Capacity Building Hands on Training for Faculty members
 - b. Research Innovation and Entrepreneurship Development programmes
 - c. Programmes on Skill Development and Employability
 - d. Digital empowerment and online education
- Professional development/administrative training programs shall be organized jointly by both institutions for teaching and non-teaching staff members.
- Orientation and training programmes for teaching and non-teaching staff members shallbe arranged to further entrain them for e governance services like e pension, e PF, WBHS.

Point of Contact

Both the institutions shall be assigning an individual as a Point of contact for carrying out the above said activities.

Financial Obligation

The agreement is absolutely non -financial in nature and does not involve any monetarytransactions between the parties for carrying out the objectives of the MOU.

Tenure and renewal of the MOU

The understanding should initially be for a period of five years and shall be renewed on themutual consent of both the institutions.



Termination of the MOU

- The MOU shall be terminated in writing and with the mutual consent of both the institutions and involvement of both the heads of institutions will be must in case of termination.
- In case of any dispute concerning this understanding the same shall be tried inmediation through the respective representatives of this understanding or any other person nominated by them.
- All disputes and differences arising out of this understanding if not settled in mediationshall be resolved in arbitration before a sole arbitrator to be jointly nominated by both the institutions herein to that effect upon mutual discussion and in terms of provisions of the arbitration and conciliation act 1996 (as amended till date). The proceedings before the erbitrator shall be in English.
- The laws of India shall be followed while adjudicating the disputes under this understanding.
- The venue of the arbitration shall be decided by the parties with mutual consent withinthe limits of city of Kolkata.

Effective period of memorandum

This cooperation agreement shall be become effective as soon as the authorized persons of allsides agree on it. There will be two copies of the memorandum equally valid one for each party effective from its dates of signing.
