Sustainable Practice: Encouraging student linkage with industry/institute and providing research exposure for higher studies and career options

Maulana Azad College is dedicated to the academic excellence of students. Its intended outcome is to:

- Provide industry/institute exposure to students right from the college level through educational tours/ excursions/ field-trips so that they have first-hand experience of the practical aspects of the subject.
- Make students aware of the latest trends in the world of research by regularly organising seminars/ symposia/ conferences/ workshops.
- Encourage students to attend similar events at other institutions and accompany them whenever required.
- Offer students career options and/or ideas for further studies and research, thereby giving them a headstart at an early stage.
- > Creating a sound academic environment in the college in the best interest of the students.

If we consider this in the context of Indian Higher Education, we find that education nowadays places a lot of emphasis on co-curricular and extra-curricular activities in addition to the prescribed syllabus. Its importance is gauged from the fact that the National Education Policy 2020 (NEP 2020) too has included hands-on learning in the form of 'Internship' for all students. This is because acquiring real-life experience can supplement the theoretical knowledge gained by students in the classroom. In view of the everincreasing competition, be it in the arena of higher studies or jobs, the interface between academia and industry/institute has assumed paramount importance. The terms 'industry' and 'institute' have been used here in a broader sense to include all types of public and private concerns, viz. companies,

factories, workshops, institutes and organisations, and other places of academic interest.

The college has been playing the role of such a catalyst for long, with the active involvement of the head of the institution, departmental teachers and IQAC through the following ways:

- Offering students exposure to latest trends in research by organising national and international seminars / symposia / conferences / workshops where reputed scholars are invited as resource persons; during the period 2018-23, Maulana Azad College has conducted close to seventy such events.
- Majority of the departments arrange educational tours to places near and far, ranging from those in and around the city of Kolkata to distant venues like Darjeeling and Dooars in north Bengal and even outside the state of West Bengal, viz. Pench in Madhya Pradesh. Some of these visits are part of the curriculum of different subjects, namely Botany, History, Microbiology, Sociology and Zoology.
- Along with the above, many other departments like Bengali, Chemistry, Economics, English, Islamic History and Culture, Philosophy, Physics and Political Science have also taken the initiative to organise educational tours on their own, irrespective of the fact that such excursions are not a compulsory part of their syllabi as mandated by the affiliating university - a noteworthy feat indeed.
- Teachers regularly encourage students to participate in events conducted by other institutions, be it local, state or national-level. They inform them about these events in the classroom as well as via social media platforms like WhatsApp groups and departmental pages on Facebook.
- Language departments like English, Persian and Urdu encourage their students to participate in programmes organised by reputed organisations like Goethe-Institut Kolkata, United States-India Educational Foundation (USIEF), Iran Society, Muslim Institute, West Bengal Urdu Academy, etc.

- Regular mentoring is carried out by teachers so that students are motivated to attend these programmes. Very often, teachers accompany the participating students to the venue for moral support and/or on-the-spot advice. While such field-trips are more common in the Science Departments, the Arts departments also conduct educational tours for experiential learning. These visits add substantially to conventional classroom studies and equip students with confidence to perform in real-life situations.
- Some teachers of the college are also supervisors for Ph.D. programmes, inspiring their students to take up research at a subsequent stage.
- Teachers of the college thus act as intermediaries and facilitate interaction between students and industry/institute through multiple channels, leading to a holistic cultivation of knowledge. Their involvement in guiding students in deciding their future career goals is thereby of paramount importance.

These initiatives on the part of the various departments have borne fruit, evinced in the academic performance of students in their University examinations and their subsequent progression.

- Close to 1100 students have progressed to higher education, be it post-graduate or professional courses from 2018-2023. It is also heartening to note that around 250 students have cracked competitive exams like CUET PG, JAM, GATE, IELTS, UGC-NET, CSIR-NET, etc. during this period.
- The placement of students in public or private sectors presents a satisfactory picture, considering the challenges in getting employment in current times, and almost 200 of them have been offered jobs in the course of this period.
- Around 120 students have benefitted from guidance for cracking competitive exams and a similar number have been given career counselling by their respective departments through formal counselling sessions. This is in addition to tips provided by the faculty members in an informal manner.
- More than 200 students have benefitted from counselling offered by their departmental teachers Owing to the above, Maulana Azad College consistently figures as a sought-after destination for students at the time of admission. It was placed at the 26th place in the country and 4th spot in West Bengal in the EW India Higher Education Ranking 2020, a nation-wide survey of best nonautonomous colleges conducted by Education World magazine in its report published in April 2020. The next year, the college improved its showing and was placed 19th in the country and 3rd in the state in the same survey published in May 2021.

However, a few problems were encountered while implementing this practice. The above-mentioned initiatives are usually taken by the teachers on their own under the aegis of the respective Heads of Department. Since there is no specific fund allotted for educational tours, teachers have to arrange for the expenditure (travel, registration, etc.) incurred in the course of these industry / institute visits either from the departmental contingency fund or raise the money through contributions from teachers and students. At times, it becomes a problem to raise adequate funds for such visits, as a result of which they cannot always be held frequently. The Covid-19 Pandemic had affected the regularity of such visits, though most of the Departments have tried to revive the practice in the 2022-23 session. A designated fund allocated for educational tours and organising seminars/ symposia/ conferences/ workshops would definitely prove to be helpful in resolving this financial issue.

A. Industry / Institute visits, Study-tours, Excursions, Field-trips above and beyond the syllabus:

• The Department of Bengali organised a field trip to the archaeological site at Chandraketugarh, a 2500year-old archaeological site in North 24 Parganas district of West Bengal on 29th February 2020. All the four Departmental teachers accompanied the students on this educational tour.



• The Department of Chemistry organized a visit to Indian Institute of Science Education and Research (IISER), Kolkata on 17th December 2019 so that students may be motivated to take up higher education and research.







The Department of Chemistry organized a visit to National Test House (Eastern Region) on 27th May 2022 to impart students a practical exposure of the calibration and testing methodologies of Paper, Textile, Rubber/Plastic, Water proofing membrane, leather, cement products, paints and enamels, chemical fertilizers, bitumen, foods etc.



• The Department of Chemistry organised a visit to the factory of Dey's Medical Limited on 16th November 2022 to familiarize and give students a practical exposure to the pharmaceutical industry.

• The Department of Economics arranged a field trip to Purulia during the period 31st January to 3rd February 2019. The team undertook a socio-economic survey in an Adivasi village where the students interacted with the residents and collected some primary data on literacy and education, health and rural infrastructure – like water supply, sanitation and health – in order to understand the state of development in the village and assess the efficacy of different welfare schemes of the government.







Sustainable Practice: Offering incentives to talented students and financial aid to needy students

Maulana Azad College is devoted to the cause of student welfare beyond the classroom. Apart from academic initiatives, the college also provides financial resources to deserving and needy students. Its aim is to:

- Offer incentive to talented students who excel in academics as well as co-curricular and extra-curricular activities, thus motivating them for further success in future studies and career.
- Provide monetary assistance to students, particularly those belonging to underprivileged social and economic sections, thereby proffering them a sense of security and assurance. This has become all the more important in the aftermath of the Covid-19 Pandemic which had adversely affected the pecuniary condition of many a family.
- Extend all possible co-operation to needy students so that they are able to continue their studies without any constraint, be it financial or otherwise.

If we consider this in the context of higher educational institutions in the city, we find that Maulana Azad College, being a government college, charges nominal tuition and hostel fees. Even so, students from underprivileged backgrounds and economically challenged families were often found to be in need of assurance and financial assistance. The college took measures in this direction to meet their requirements through various private and government scholarships and freeships, as well as the Student Aid Fund. The financial situation of many students had declined during the Covid-19 Pandemic, and the college took prompt initiatives to provide relief to such students from affected families, thereby preventing these pupils from discontinuing their studies. Alongside, it must be remembered that meritorious students from all sections require continual encouragement and incentive, and the college earnestly tries to provide that. Earlier, the Alumni Association of the college used to organise prize distribution ceremonies every year where toppers from all subjects were felicitated. In recent times, the college has been organising such programmes where rank-holders and achievers are duly awarded.

The college has constantly tried to aid and incentive to students through the following means:

- The College authority issued notices for talent-search whereby the departments were asked to recommend names of students with potential in academics as also co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.
- Toppers in all the subjects (both UG and PG batches) are incentivised either in cash or kind. The names of students scoring highest marks in the University examination are sought from all the departments. The Student Support Cell of the college organises a programme to distribute prizes in the form of books, certificates, and trophies. The practice was repeated in 2023 too, where the winners were given cheques of Rs 1000/- each, as also certificates, trophies and pens.
- Similarly, student achievers who had been selected to prestigious universities and institutes for further studies were given Rs 5000/- each in 2023. Meritorious students are thus given adequate attention and their accomplishments recognised.
- The college has been diligently processing all types of government and private scholarships over many years. When the Covide-19 Pandemic struck in 2020, it dealt an adverse impact on regular life. Amid this crisis, the College authority issued a notice, when the college campus was

closed due to the Lockdown, informing that financially weak and needy students would be provided assistance by the college so that their studies are not hampered.

- Such students were required to send an application to their respective Heads of Departments through email with adequate supporting documents. The Head of the Department, in turn, forwarded these emails to the college Principal for necessary action.
- The Student Support Cell of the college received these applications and held meetings (some of them in online mode) to deliberate on the course of action. Based on their recommendations, the college office started the formalities of transferring grants of Rs Two Thousand and Five Hundred each to sixty students through bank transfer.
- In the academic session 2022-23, four students of Sociology Department who could not afford the full amount of Rs 8000/- required for their compulsory Field Study applied to the College authority for financial aid. The Head of the Department of Sociology forwarded their applications, and following the recommendation of the Student Support Cell, these four students received around 45% of the trip expenditure from the Student Aid Fund via bank transfer.
- Four students of the History Department who were facing economic hardship similarly applied to the College authority for financial assistance. The Head of the Department of History forwarded their applications, and following the same procedure of recommendation by the Student Support Cell, the college office issued cheques of Rs One Thousand each to these students.

The success of this initiative is evident from the fact that Maulana Azad College has facilitated monetary aids, scholarships, full and half-freeships more than ten thousand during the years 2018-23, and students from all categories have benefitted from these. The auditing team from Principal Accountant General (A & E), West Bengal, had conducted a government audit from 26th September to 30th September 2023. The team in its report praised Maulana Azad College for 'promoting inclusiveness in higher studies with financial support to fellow students in all disciplines'. Such words of commendation have encouraged the college to continue this practice in the upcoming years too. Students showing promise are given proper encouragement so that they may nurture their myriad talents. It has been decided that toppers from all subjects would be awarded prizes on 5th September every year, the day also celebrated as Teachers' Day across India. Similarly, outstanding achievers would be felicitated during the Induction Day when newly-admitted students come to the college for the first time to attend their Orientation Programme, thereby providing them inspiration to excel like their seniors.

While carrying out this exercise, a few problems were faced. Students nowadays get the benefit of various government and private scholarships, viz. Kanyashree, Aikyashree, Swami Vivekananda Merit-cum-Means Scholarship, Oasis Scholarship, Jindal Scholarship, etc. However, since the economic situation of many families has deteriorated, particularly in the wake of the Pandemic, the amount received from one scholarship is not always sufficient to meet the diverse needs of students, leading to a steady increase in the number of applicants. This has caused great anxiety to the Student Support Cell as their members are forced to make difficult decisions in selecting candidates for financial help. The corpus of the Student Aid Fund being rather limited, not all those students who had applied for assistance could be provided with the necessary grants. Being a government educational institution, the college cannot arbitrarily hike fees to expand its financial corpus. It was realised that a larger corpus of funds was required to meet all such pleas of needy students.





To further encourage this initiative of offering aid and incentives, funds from public and private concerns including Industry and Business Houses in the form of Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) as well as Alumni Association and similar organisations may be created. This can enable the college to directly extend financial assistance to needy students in a speedy and convenient manner.

Sustainable Practice: Nurturing an environment-friendly green campus through sustainable practices

Maulana Azad College is committed to nurturing an environment-friendly green campus through sustainable practices. Its aim is to:

- Adopt policies and undertake activities that contribute to creating a green, clean and environmentfriendly atmosphere in the campus and beyond.
- Use power-efficient gadgets and equipment in order to decrease the carbon-footprint.
- Emphasise the use of renewable sources of energy to create an eco-friendly ambience.
- Cultivate environment-friendly habits amongst students and staff of the college.
- Promote environmental awareness through continual campaigns and drives.
- Foster sustainability in the college campus by striving to follow the guidelines of the central and state government which serve as the underlying principles for this practice.

If we consider this issue in the context of higher educational institutions in Kolkata, we find that Maulana Azad College is situated in the heart of the city and on the main road with heavy vehicular traffic. The campus is surrounded by a locality which has a very dense human habitation. Moreover, the neighbourhood is a buzzing business centre with numerous shops and establishments, including workshops and small-scale industries. Therefore, the area is congested, and is also frequented by people throughout the day for various commercial purposes. In view of this scenario of high-risk environmental factors, it is quite challenging to maintain a green and clean campus.

Despite its locational limitations, the college has endeavoured to create a clean, green and environmentfriendly campus. Duly guided by the various rules and regulations of the central and state government, the college has framed policies (Energy management policy, green campus policy and Waste management policy) to promote a green and environment-friendly campus. It strives to uphold this mission in the following ways:

- Tree plantation in the college campus and hostel premises, particularly during the 'Aranya Saptaha'. Students are encouraged to take care of these saplings, with guidance from the NSS unit of the college and Botany Department.
- Cultivating a medicinal plant garden in one of the four gardens (Charbagh area) in the campus, and using organic fertilizers, compost, and eco-friendly pesticides.
- Using power-efficient electrical appliances and gadgets like star-rated air-conditioning machines, refrigerators, microwave ovens, etc.
- Installing LED lights and BLDC fans in the college and hostel to decrease electricity consumption.
- Adopting solar power through solar panels, and water-conservation (including rainwater harvesting and groundwater recharging).
- Regular cleaning of the college campus and hostel premises by NSS volunteers. On occasions, they also undertake such collaborative outreach drives beyond the campus like the Kolkata Maidan and Mullick Ghat on the bank of the Hooghly River.
- Organising seminars, workshops, etc. on environment-related issues regularly. While most of these are conducted in the college seminar hall, campus and adjoining areas, some events were also held online during the COVID-19 lockdown.
- Celebrating commemorative days like World Environment Day and World Biodiversity Day on 5th June and 22nd May with much fanfare.

- Putting up posters and signage at strategic places in the college and hostel to create awareness about environmental issues like conservation of Energy and water.
- Installing a Multiple sensor Remote sensing Air Quality and Air noise Monitoring system (AQMS and ANMS) with LED display unit in front of the college building to indicate Air Quality Index, Noise Level in decibels, etc. using Remote Sensing (RS) and Geographical Information System (GIS) to showcase these parameters.
- Training on waste management from specialized organisations like Garbage Free India (GFI) and Indian Oil (under Swachh Bharat program) so that there is proper segregation of different types of waste right at the source.
- Collaborating with NGOs like Vital Waste to manage and dispose of waste generated in the college campus and hostel premises.
- Disposing of electronic waste through agencies like WEBEL and Hulladek.
- Organic compost/ aerobic compost pits dug, and leaf-composting practised by the students of the Botany Department in association with NSS Volunteers and GFI.
- Minimising the use of plastic in the campus, especially single-use plastic. A recycle bank for plastic bottles has been created on the ground floor of the college so that they may be recycled.
- Environmental Studies is part of the curriculum and has been a compulsory subject for Undergraduate students of Maulana Azad College since 2001.
- The college conducts green/environment and energy audits regularly, and takes due measures accordingly.

These efforts have borne fruit in the following ways:

- The introduction of solar power in April 2021 by means of rooftop solar panels has been a significant achievement on the part of the college. The city of Kolkata, having a substantial summer season, leads to the generation of a reasonable quantity of solar energy which is subsequently be wheeled to the main electricity grid of the Calcutta Electric Supply Corporation (CESC). This net-metering not only results in reduction in expenditure on monthly electric bills, but also contributes to optimum usage of natural resources.
- The college has received substantial appreciation for adopting these practices from reputed external agencies like Hulladek, Vital Waste, Garbage Free India as well as the auditing body Management System Consultancy.
- It has also received ISO 50001:2018, ISO 9001:2015 and ISO 9001:2015 certifications from Assurance Quality Certification LLC for maintaining efficient energy management and green environment strategy in the college campus.
- However, a few problems were encountered while carrying out this practice. Sometimes, the equipment required for an environment-friendly campus malfunctioned, as evident during the period October 2022 to May 2023 when the solar panels could not generate solar power and offset the monthly electricity bills of the college. This implied that maintenance is a major aspect of such appliances and gadgets and needs to be given due attention.

Clean and green campus initiatives: A Green Campus is a place where environmentally friendly practices and education combine to promote sustainable and eco-friendly practices in the campus. Green campus activities are becoming integral part of modern-day education system and educational institutions act as pioneers in promoting these principles within society. To strongly support a sustainable and climate friendly environment, Maulana Azad college initiated this program. This practice involves the use of energy efficient measures, comprehensive recycling and green landscaping in the campus.

Green and clean campus is the responsibility of everyone. For this purpose, the following measures have been considered by the college:

Plastic free zone: Maulana Azad College has imposed a ban on use of plastic, especially single-use plastic, inside the campus to address environmental hazards. All the Students, Teaching and Non-teaching staff are strictly requested to avoid single-use plastic inside the college campus and follow the guidelines issued by the University Grants Commission.

Ban on smoking, tobacco and tobacco products: Considering the serious health issues, Maulana Azad College has also strictly banned smoking and chewing of tobacco products like gutkha, paan masala, etc. inside the college campus.

Use of solar energy and energy conservation: 20 kWp Rooftop Solar PV Power Plant, sanctioned by West Bengal Renewable Energy Development Agency (WBREDA), Kolkata, an autonomous organisation under Non-Conventional and Renewable Energy Sources, Government of West Bengal, started producing electricity in the grid from April, 2021, thereby augmenting the overall energy scenario of the college.

In college LED bulbs, BLDC fans, star rated air conditioners with timer and refrigerators are used to save and conserve energy. Faculty members of the institution motivate students in implementing the minimal use of air conditioners, switching off light, fans etc.

Waste Management: Non-hazardous solid garbage from the college campus and college canteen is segregated in waste collection bins, disinfected with formalin or bleaching powder, and

Campus cleaning: Students are encouraged to use paper and cloth bag to minimize the use of plastic. Dustbins are kept in every classroom, laboratory, corridor, porch, and college premises for maintaining cleanliness. The NSS unit of the college deserves a special mention for organizing regular campus cleaning campaigns, inside

and outside the campus to motivate students, shopkeepers, and the community at large.














